Police Officer Employment Opportunity Lateral Entry and Non-Certified

Applications are being accepted for the position of full-time Police Officer with the Wyoming Police Department. We are a service-oriented, progressive law enforcement agency that embraces the community oriented policing philosophy. Our Police Officer's duties include protecting life and property, enforcement of laws and ordinances, routine patrol, investigation, traffic enforcement, specialized assignments, community outreach, and general calls for service.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 21 years of age.
- Must be able to work as part of a team and in a professional atmosphere.
- Must have strong interpersonal and problem solving skills.
- Background must be free of prior felony convictions and certain misdemeanor convictions.
- Must not have tattoos, body art or branding that is visible while in the uniform of the day.
- Must be physically capable of successfully performing the essential job functions of the Police Officer classification and be free of medical conditions that would preclude one from successfully performing said functions or would pose a direct threat to the health or safety of oneself or others.

- Salary range for certified officers \$63,875 \$71,738. (Certified less than 2 years \$61,636.)
- Non-Certified salary starts at \$46,343 Starting salary commensurate with experience.
- 100% pension pick-up.
- Generous vacation and leave policy.
- Accrued sick time with another department can be transferred.
- Service time can be transferred and will be used for purposes of calculating vacation.
- Health, Dental, Vision and Life Insurance available.
