HURRICANE HELENE WRECKS HAVOC IN THE SOUTHEAST

Discharge Petition Successful!!!

An historic accomplishment was achieved in getting 218 signatures on the Discharge Petition to force a floor vote on HR 82, the Social Security Fairness Act. But....this is just the beginning!

The Congress has adjourned until after the election and are scheduled to return on November 12. We need to use this time to thank the Ohio members of the House of Representatives for being co-sponsors of the legislation and ask them to affirm their support of HR 82. FOP of Ohio Fighting for your PENSION!!

The FOP of Ohio is fighting the keep our pensions strong and stable. We have joined a coalition called the Alliance for Prosperity and a Secure Retirement. FOP of Ohio Pension Committee member Kathy Harrell is on the Board of the National Conference on Public Employee Retirement Systems and the FOP has three members serving on the Board of the Ohio Police and Fire (OP-F) Pension System. We believe that having a strong relationship with the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) is so important that Vice President Assion will be working with me to make sure we are keeping tabs on OPERS and make our voices heard for our members in that system.

The FOP of Ohio's top priorities for the lame duck session of the General Assembly is HB 296, HB 84 and HB 492. All three are pension related bills. We will be working with our friends at the Ohio Association of Professional Fire Fighters on getting a vote on HB 296 to raise the employer's rates they pay towards our pensions. We will be asking for your help in reaching out to the legislature soon on that very topic.



FOP of Ohio Pushes out App



The Fraternal Order of Police regrets to report that as of midnight on 30 September there have been 283 officers shot in the line of duty so far in 2024. Of those officers shot, 42 of them were killed. Leaders need to condemn violence at every opportunity and the Congress needs to pass the Protect and Serve Act!
